TO CAMPERS AND THEIR PARENTS:

We are looking forward to your arrival at Luther Heights this summer! Enclosed are some things to help you get prepared for an exciting week at Luther Heights!

1. **Registration Confirmation & Statement of Fees.** Please check the session and date that we have you or your child registered for. The statement of fees may or may not reflect any amount that your home congregation has agreed to pay. If we know the amount that a congregation intends to contribute we have included that. If you know the amount that your congregation intends to contribute, please adjust the balance owed accordingly.
 - The balance owed may be paid when you arrive at camp; or if you would like to have all the payments completed beforehand, you may send them by mail. If you do pre-pay, it helps us when you include this statement with your payment.
2. **Health History and Examination Form.** It is essential that we have this form on file when campers are with us, so we can provide proper health care and respond appropriately to any emergencies.
 - The form requires **two signatures**: from parent or guardian and from the camper. See information on the other side of this letter for additional information on completing the Health Form. When the form is completed and signed, mail it back to us in the enclosed envelope, **at least three weeks before** your arrival at camp. Earlier is better!
3. **Permission Form.** This describes camp program activities and known risks. Parents of minor campers and adult participants must read this form carefully, sign it, and return it to the camp (with the health form) **at least three weeks prior** to arrival at camp. No one may participate in the program without a signed Health Form and Permission Form.
4. **Horseback Ride & Rafting Forms.** These forms must be completed for anyone who plans to go on a horseback ride or a raft trip. Please send the Permission form(s) in **at least three weeks prior** to your arrival at camp.
5. **Cabin mate.** If you have requested a cabin mate with your registration, we will make every effort to house you with that person. If your choice changes, or you would like to add a cabin mate prior to camp please let us know **at least two weeks before camp**. Assignments are complex and it's difficult to make changes at registration.
6. **Other Information** is enclosed on what to take to camp, what to expect at camp, how to prepare for it and other information.
7. **Registration** is from 2:00 - 5:00pm on the first day of Camp. Introduction to Camp sessions start on Saturday and Tuesday. The Family Camps starting dates vary.
8. **Camper pickup** is from 1:00 - 2:30pm on the last day of Camp. If someone other than the parent/guardian is going to pick up the Camper please notify us at registration.
9. **Memory CD.** A slide show of your week at Camp with music is available for \$10.00. In addition to the slide show a file with between 200-400 pictures is also included.
10. **Luau.** The last night of youth sessions has traditionally had a banquet theme. This year the theme will be a Luau. You don't need to bring special 'Luau' clothes but you may.

Sending in the paperwork prior to Camp enables us to quickly register campers at registration. If you have any questions, please contact the camp office. Thank you for your registration!
